Soil nutrient test

Which nutrients are found in soil?

The three major macronutrients needed by plants are nitrogen (N), phosphorus (P) and potassium (K). These nutrients are found in differing amounts in soil depending on the season, inputs of organic matter, compost or fertilizer. Different plants need these nutrients in various amounts determined by their growth stage and species.

Materials

100 ml of soil Soil sieve or wire mesh colander LaMotte complete soil test kit or LusterLeaf Rapitest soil test kit

Procedure
